principle

- beam size measurement
 - scan by the mover stage of whole laser system
 - scattered photon counting
- requirements
 - thin laser width ($5\ \mu\text{m}$)
 - high effective power (100W)
- our solution
 - external optical cavity with a small waist
 - power enhancement
 - well defined laser profile

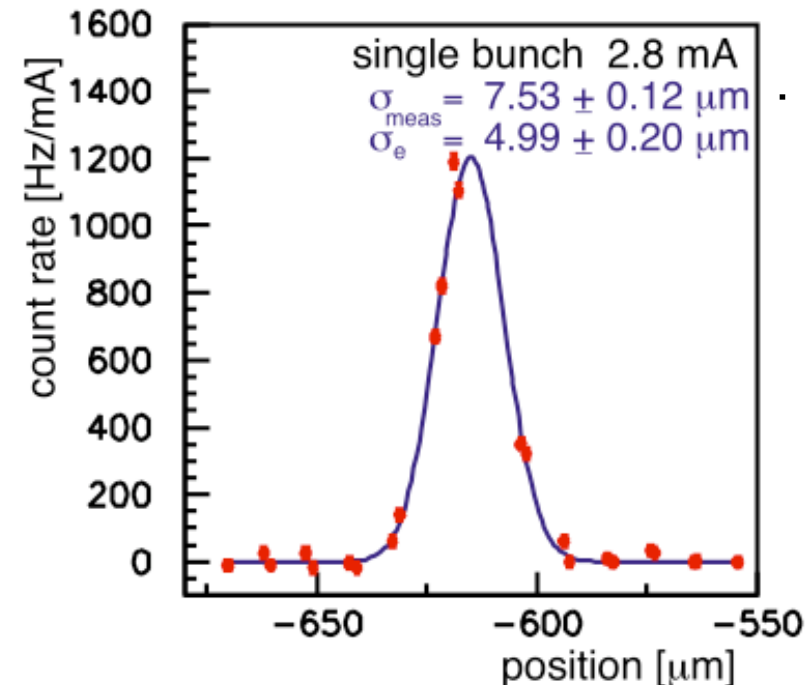
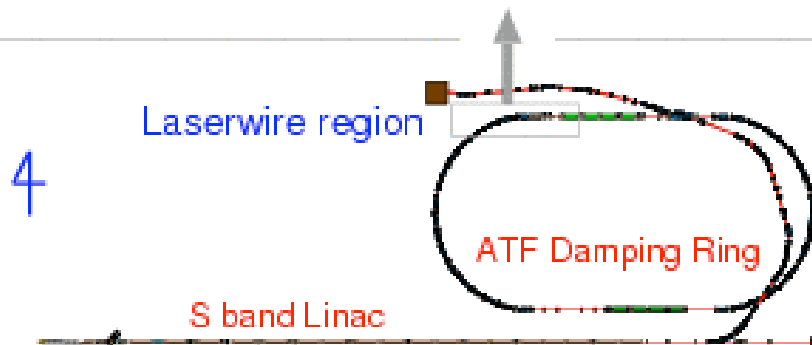
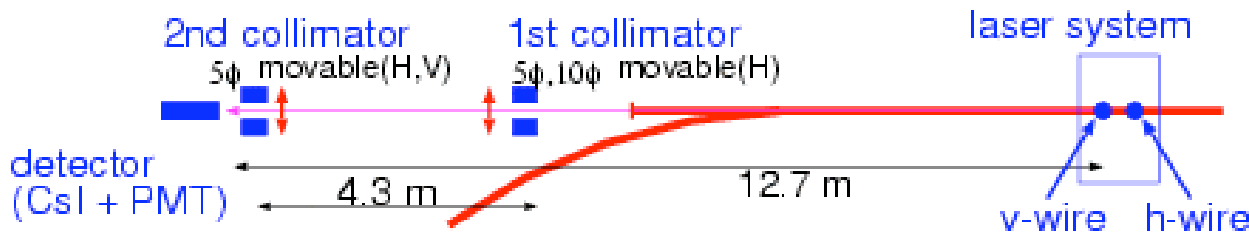
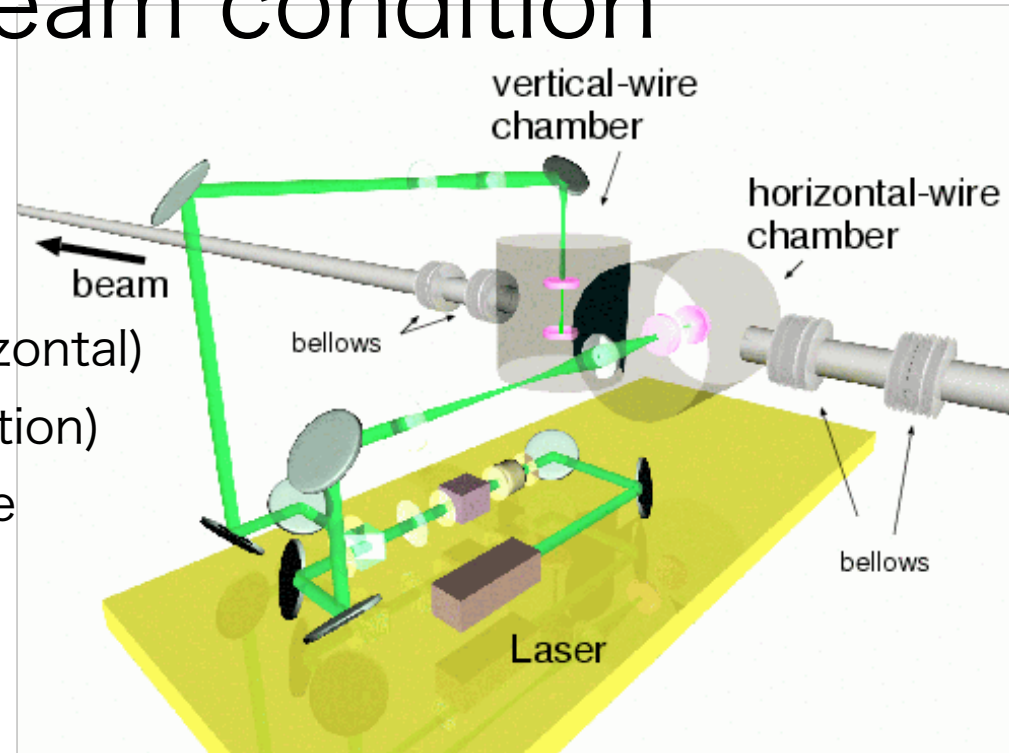

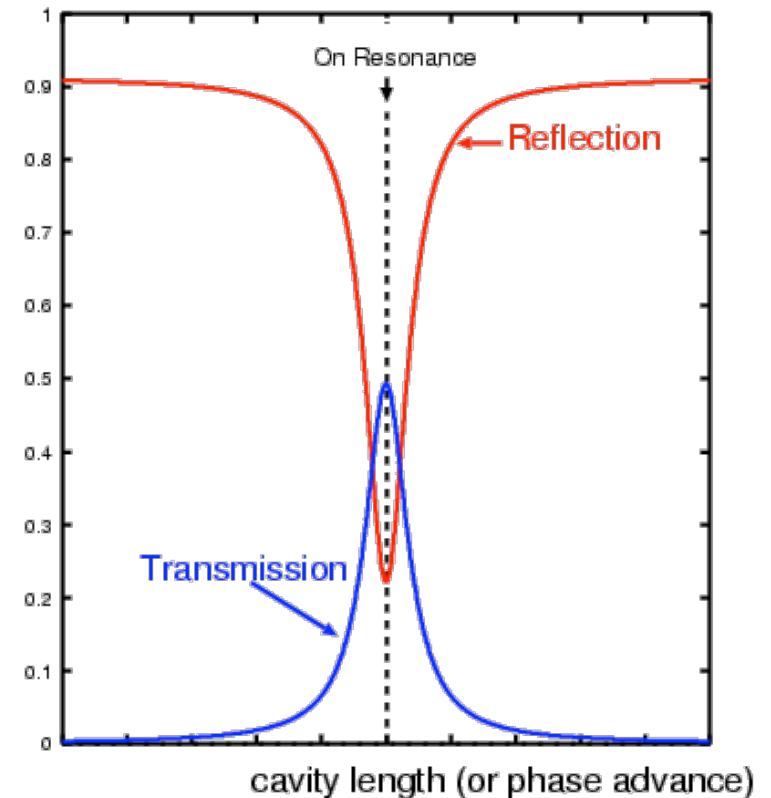
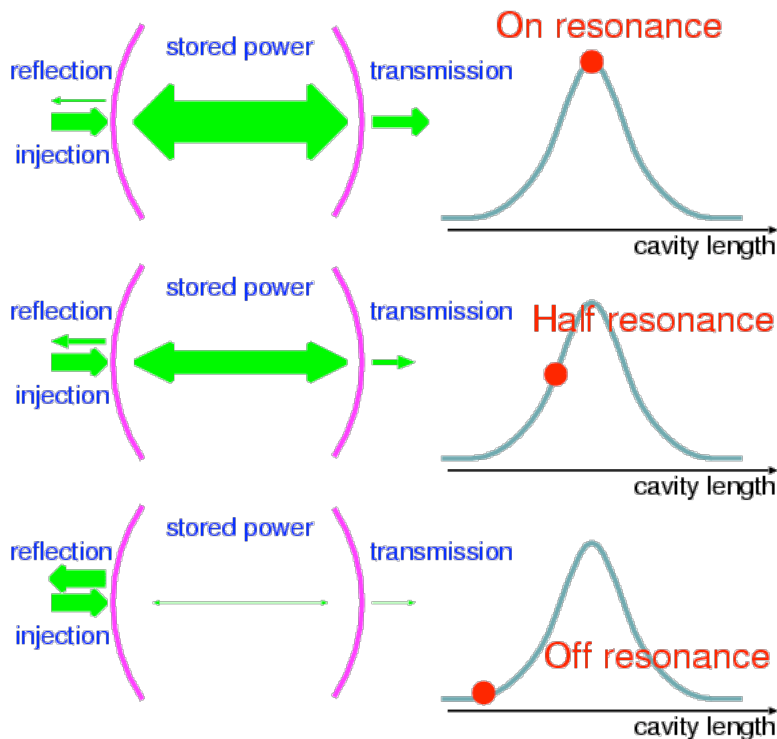
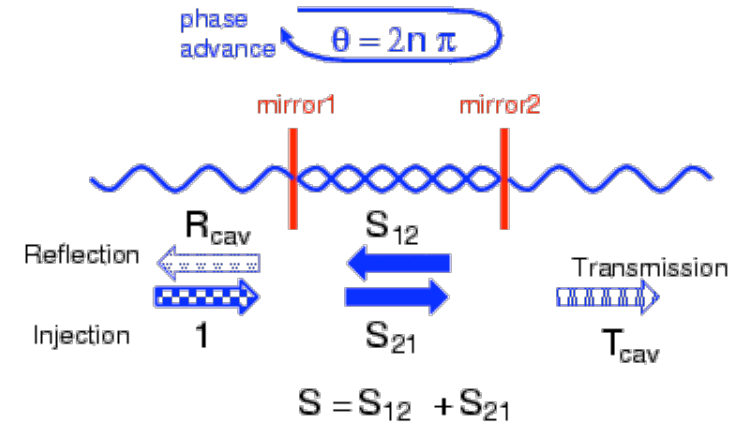
layout and e-beam condition

- electron beam to be measured
 - typically, $5\mu\text{m}$ (vertical), $100\mu\text{m}$ (horizontal)
 - single or multi-bunch(2.8nsec separation)
 - stored beam in an equilibrium state

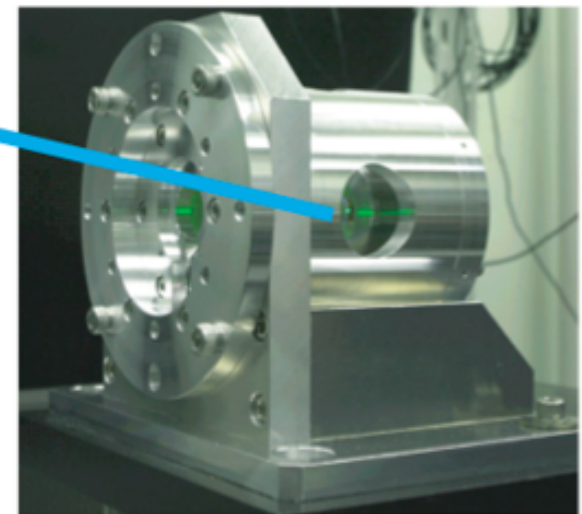
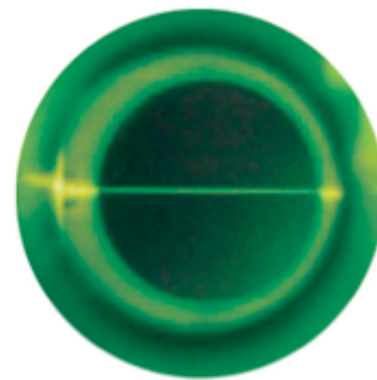
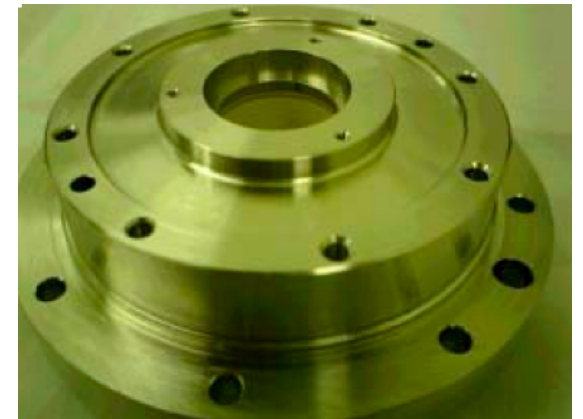
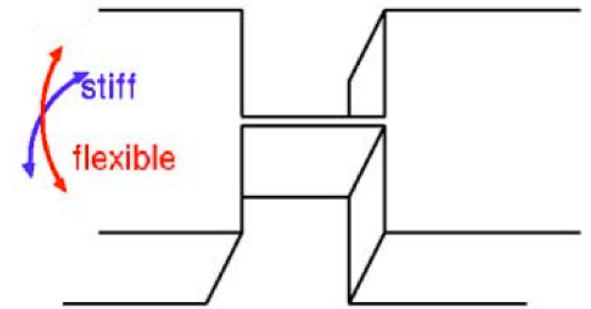
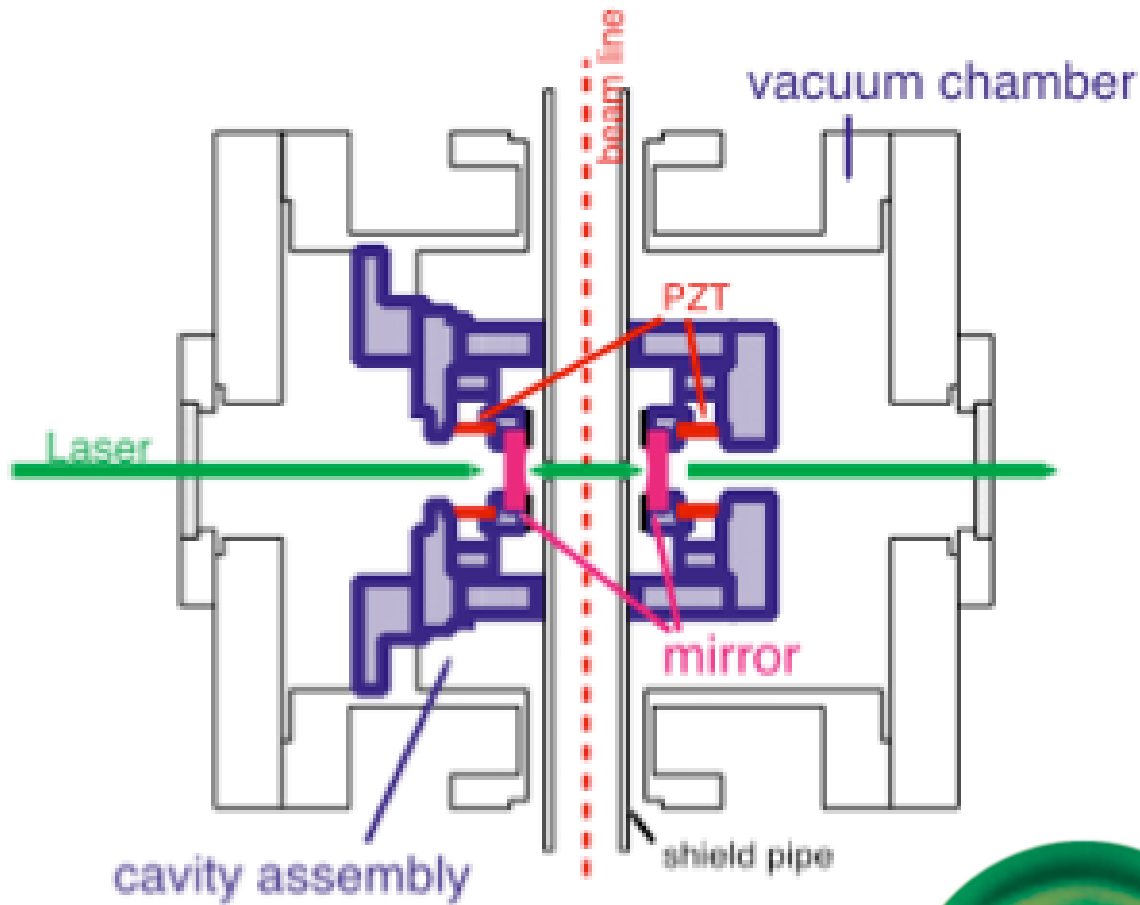


power enhancement

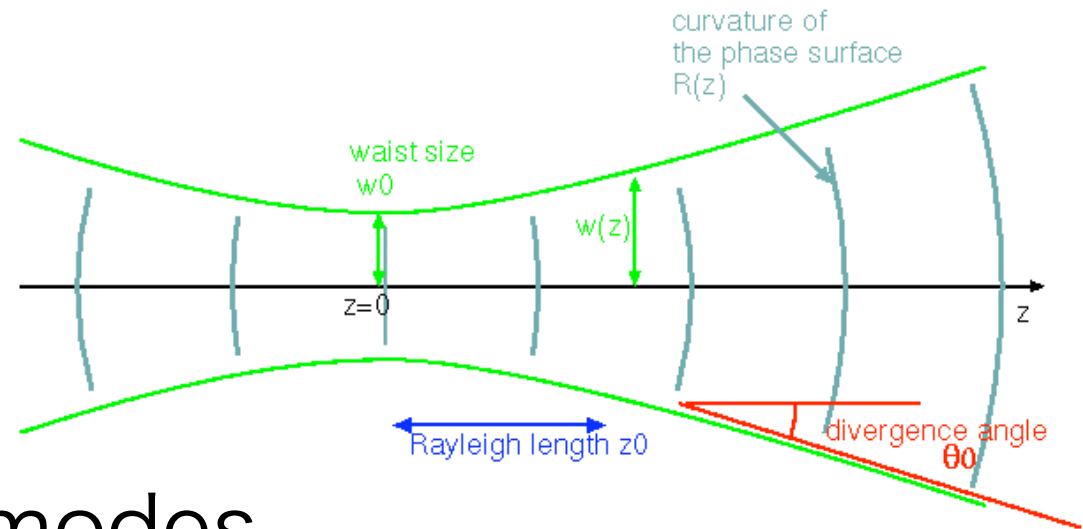
- resonance condition ($L = n\lambda / 2$)
- transmission power tells the status
- enhancement factor is proportional to
 - sharpness of the peak (finesse)
 - transmission of the coupler mirror

laser beam stored in a cavity

- boundary condition by the mirrors
 - L, ρ define beam waist (and λ)
- if $L > 2\rho$, no solution (unstable resonator)

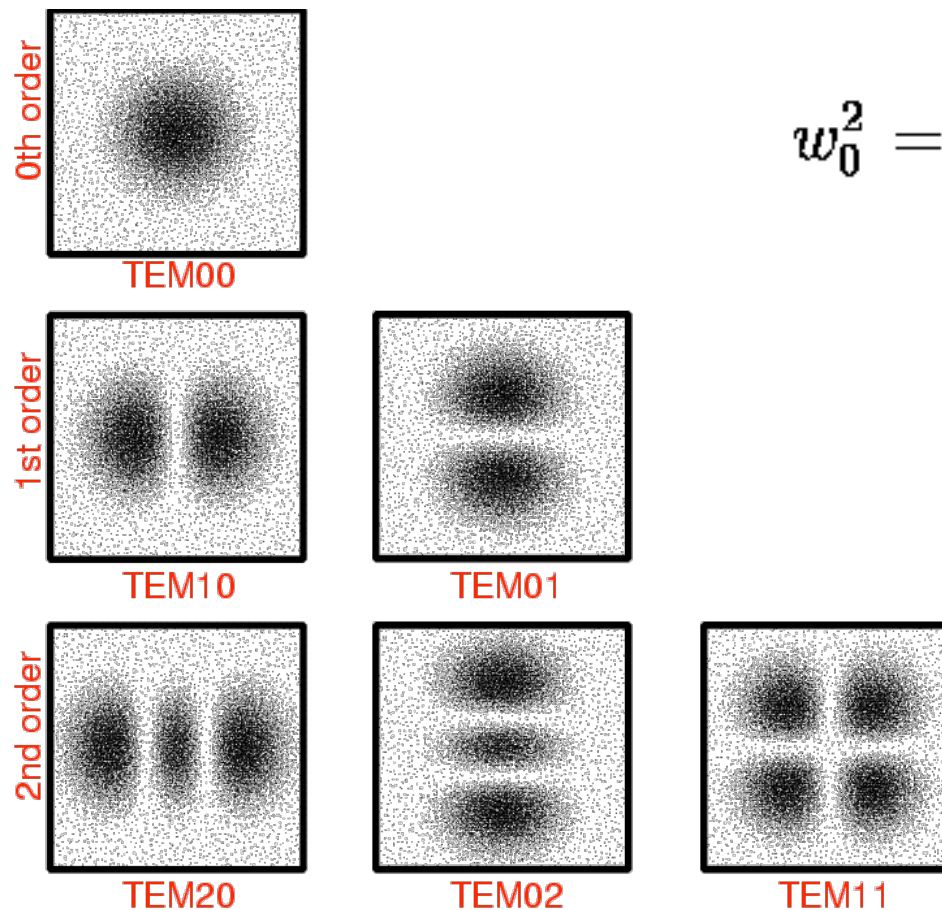
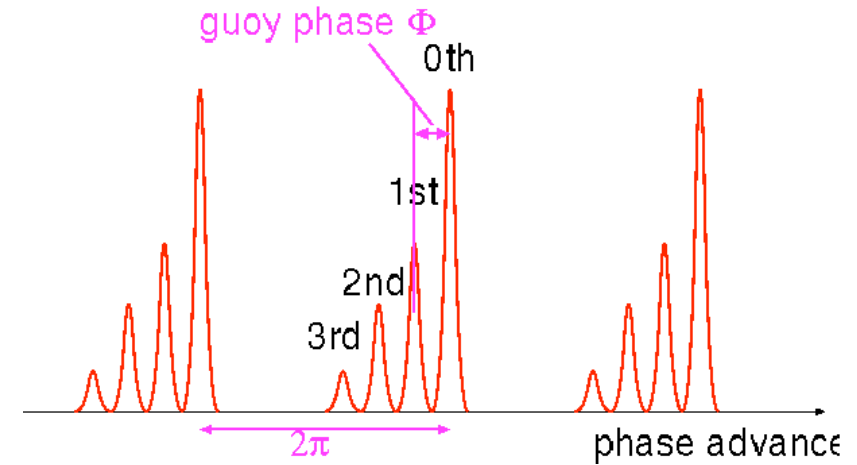


$$w_0^2 = \frac{\lambda}{\pi} \frac{\sqrt{L(2\rho - L)}}{2}$$



transverse modes

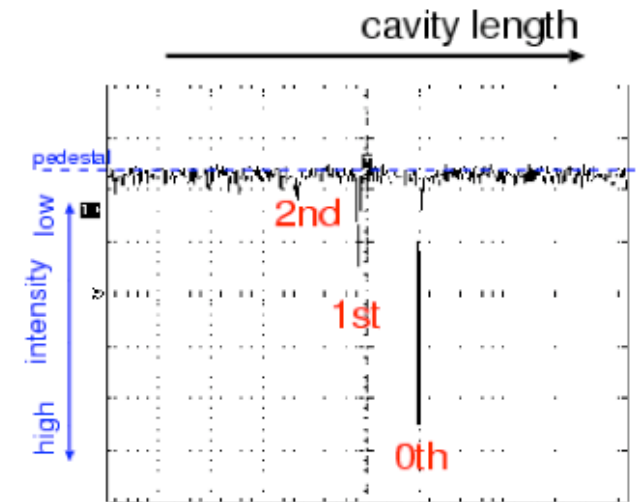
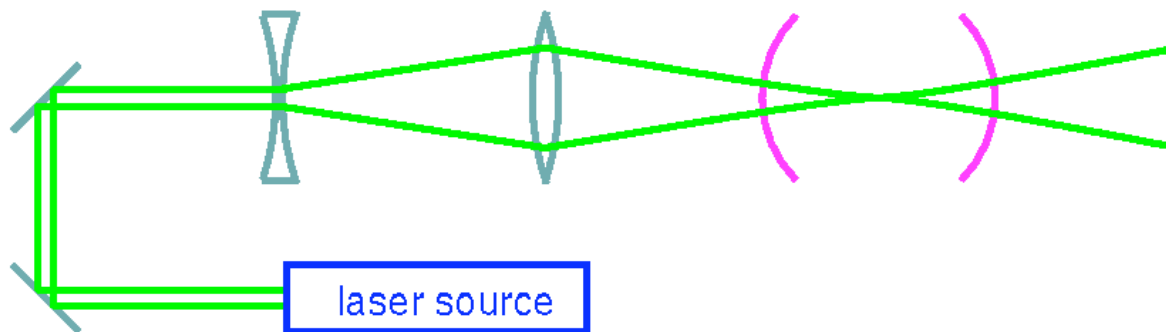
- $m, n > 0$
- additional phase factor
 - resonance condition shifts
 - amount of the shift is related to w_0



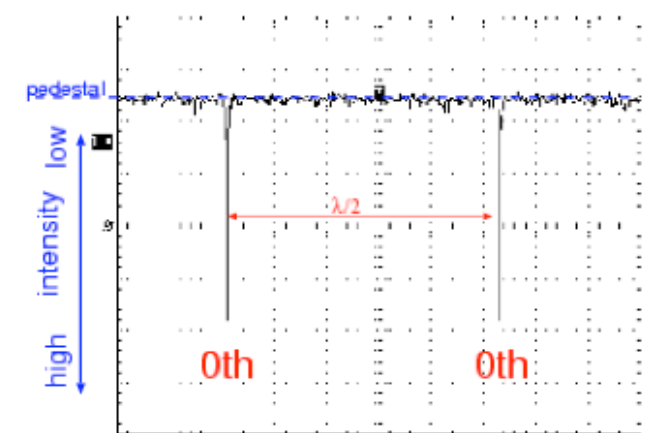

optics tuning

- sweep the cavity length using PZT
- observe excitation modes through cavity transmission

cavity length

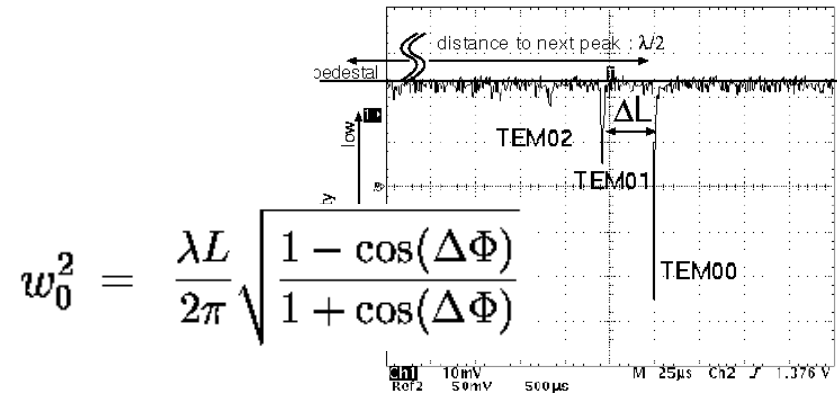

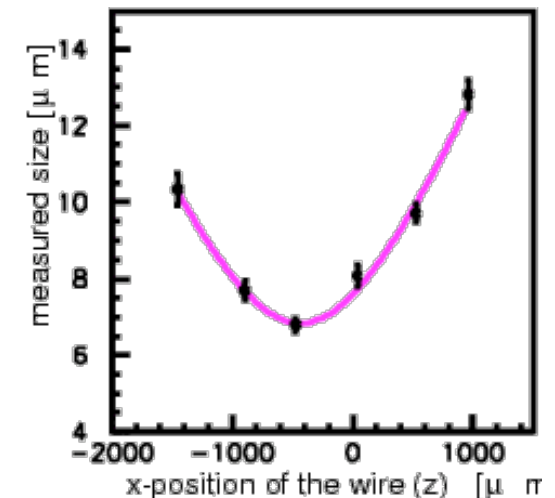
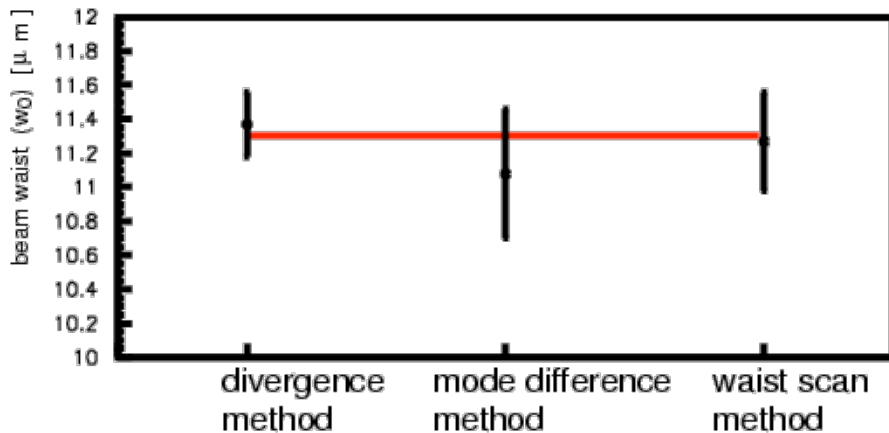
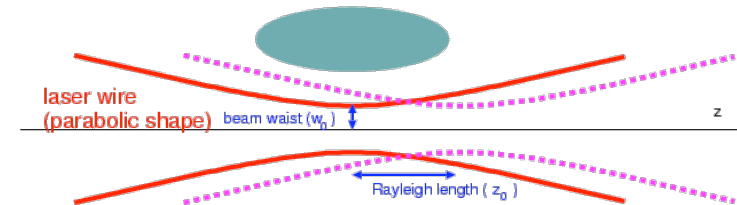
measurement of laser waist

$$\theta_0 \equiv w(z)/z \approx \frac{\lambda}{\pi w_0}$$

- Three methods
 - divergence of cavity transmission
 - phase difference in transverse modes
 - waist scan with electron beam
- result
- $w_0 = 11.3 \pm 0.16 \mu\text{m}$, $z_0 = 760 \mu\text{m}$

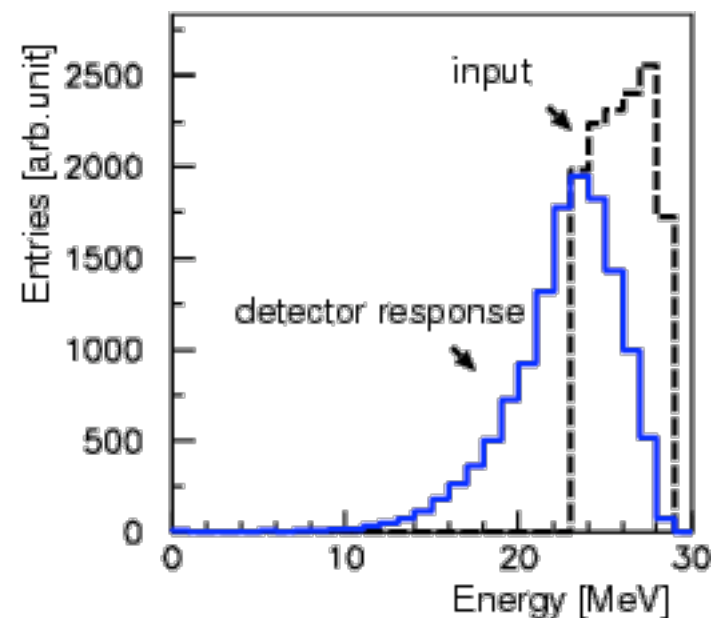
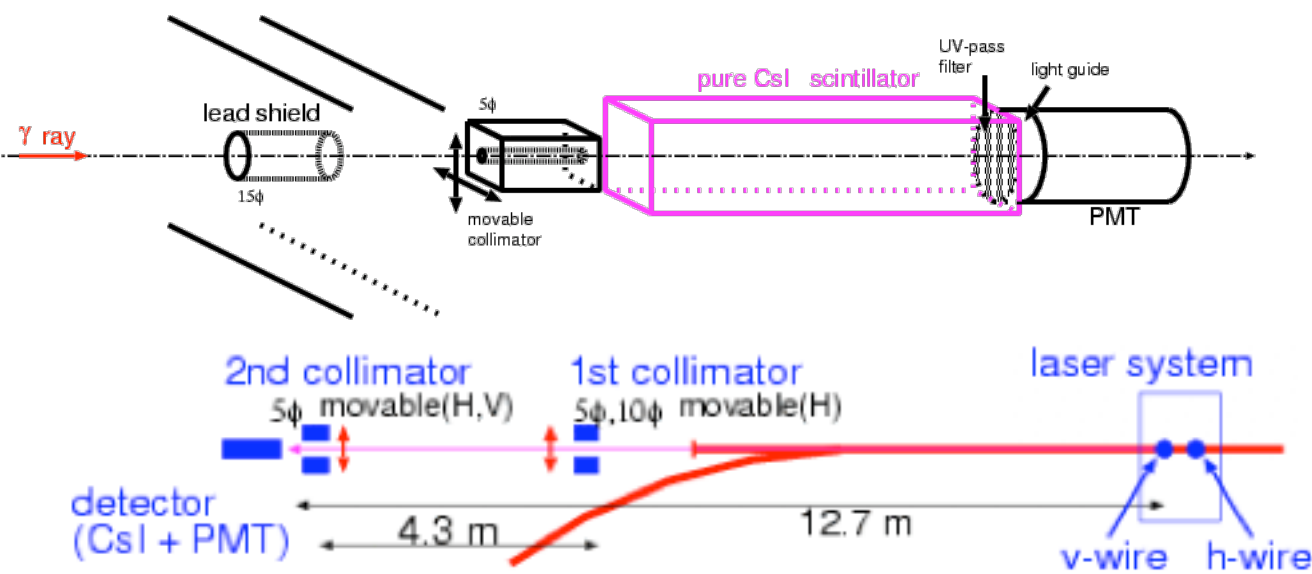
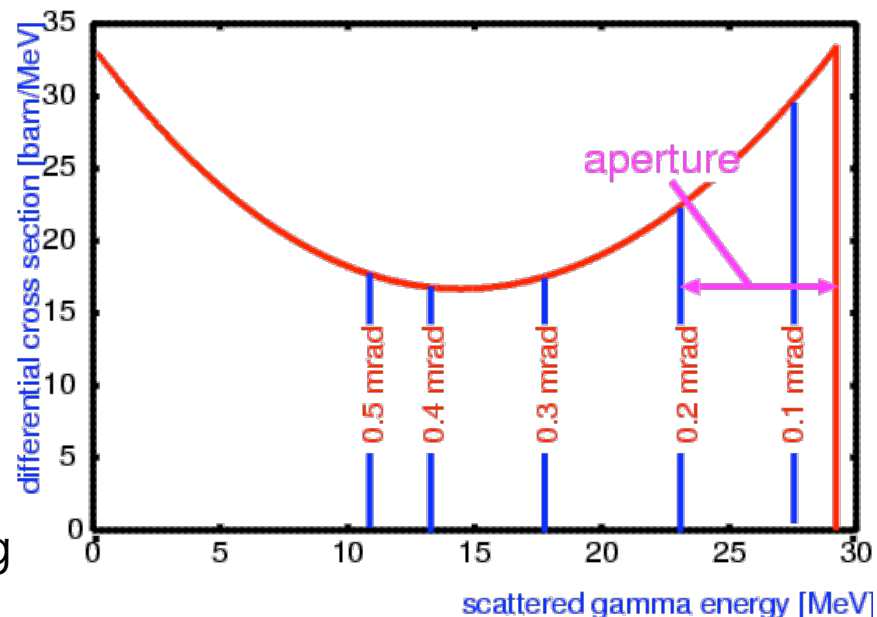

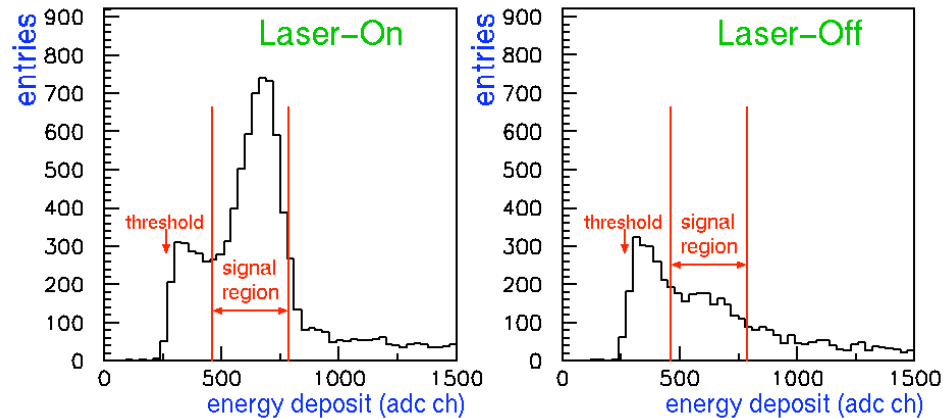
Compton signal detection

- Max. energy 29MeV
- detector
 - CsI(pure): 70mm×70mm×300mm
 - leading edge: 0.56nsec
 - counting
- background
 - spent electron via intra-beam scattering
 - reduce detector aperture



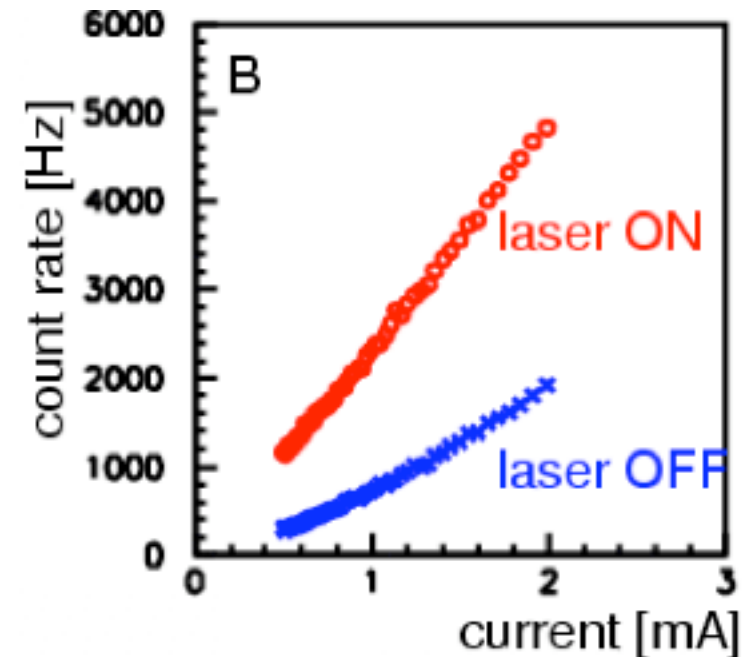
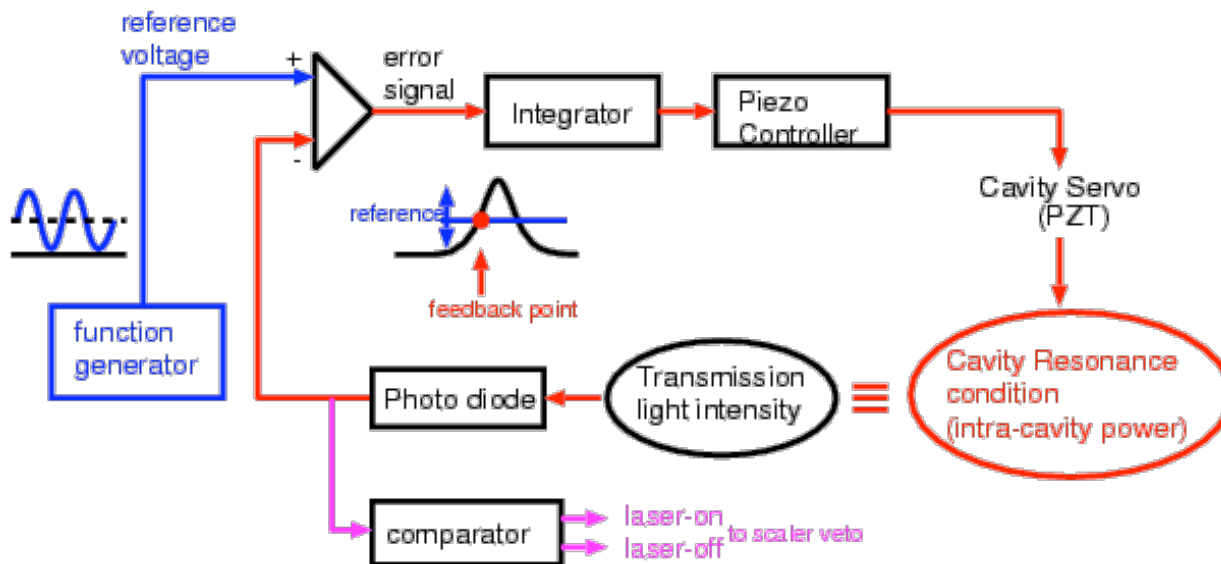
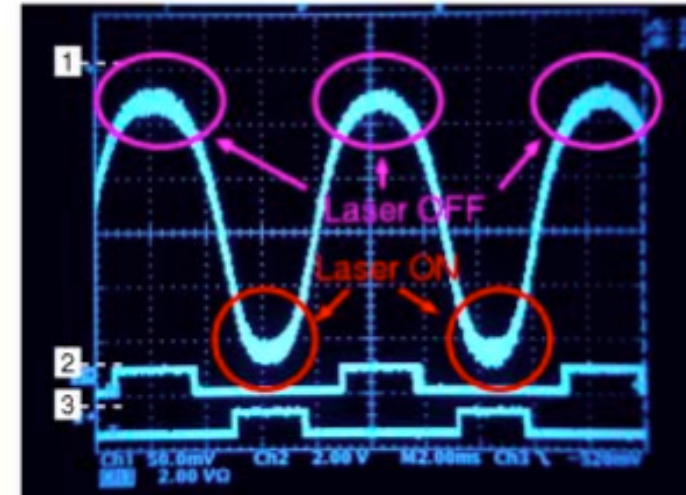

 - on/off resonance



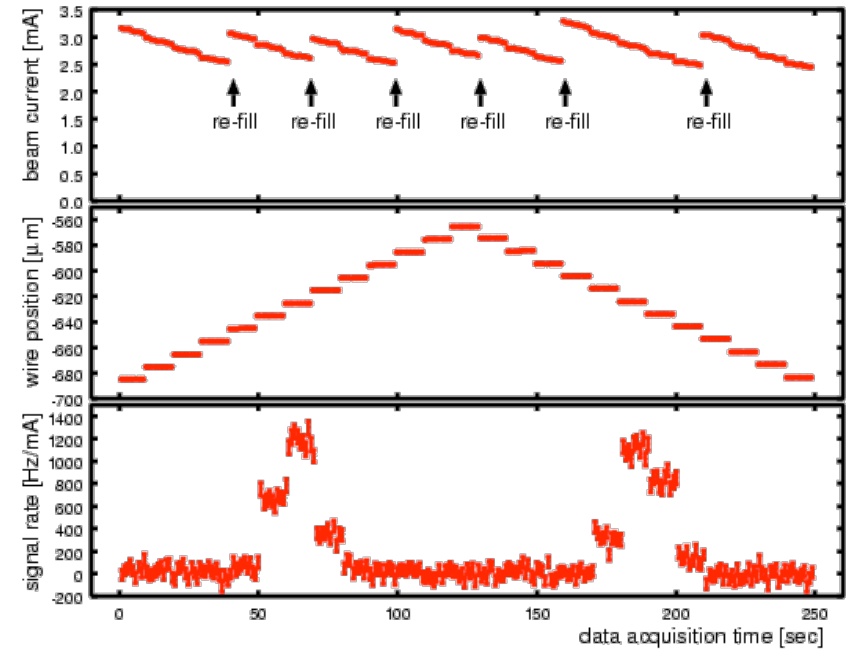

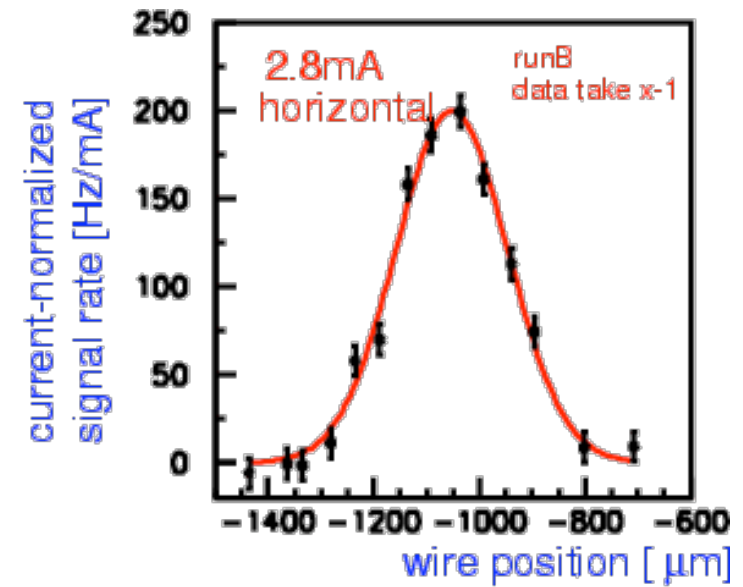
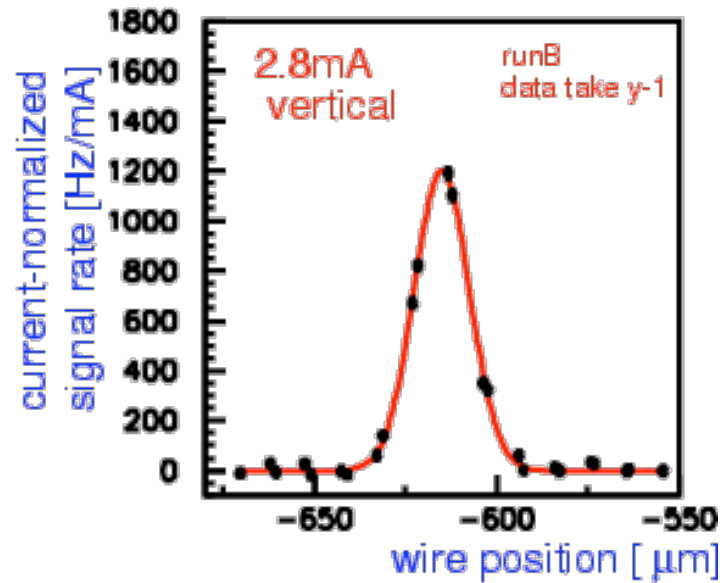


measurement example

- procedure
 - storage beam in DR
 - $10\mu\text{m}$ step, 10sec/position
 - re-fill DR

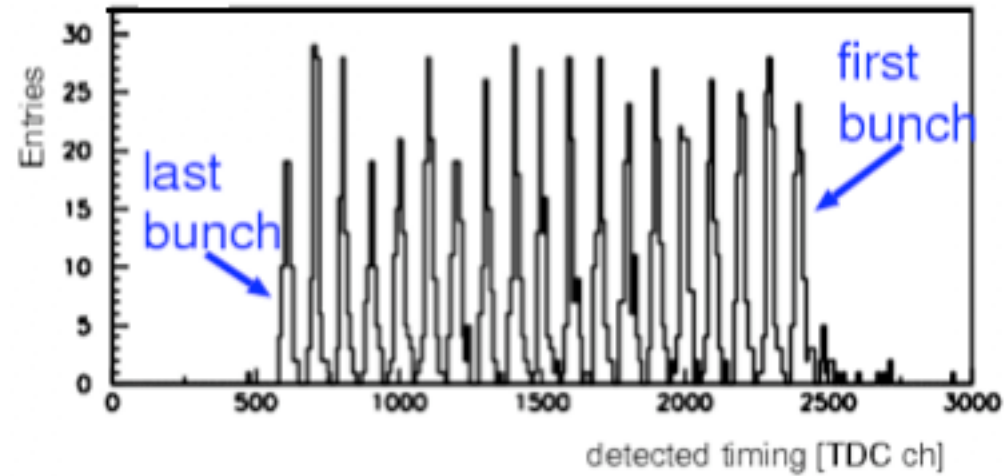

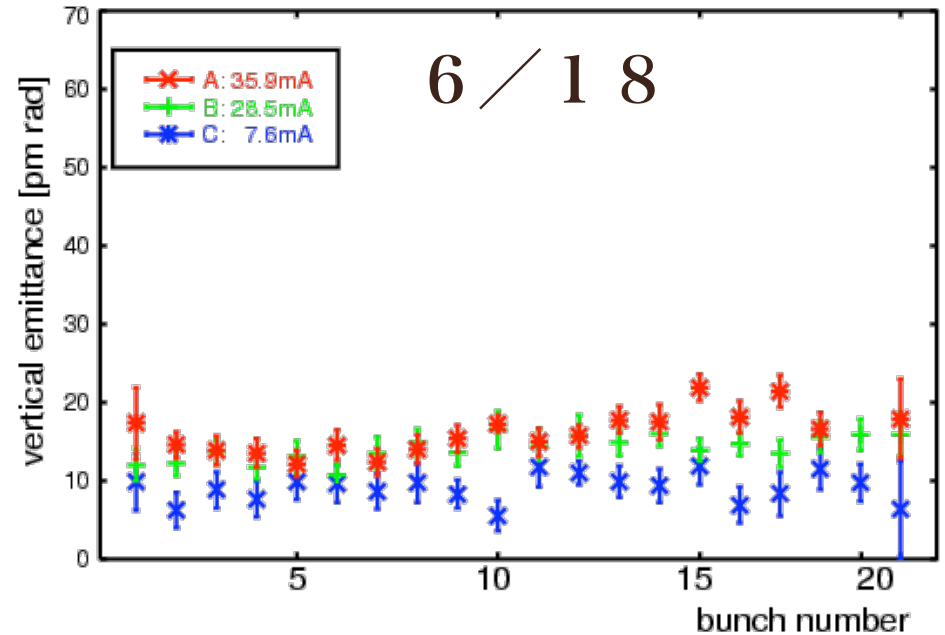
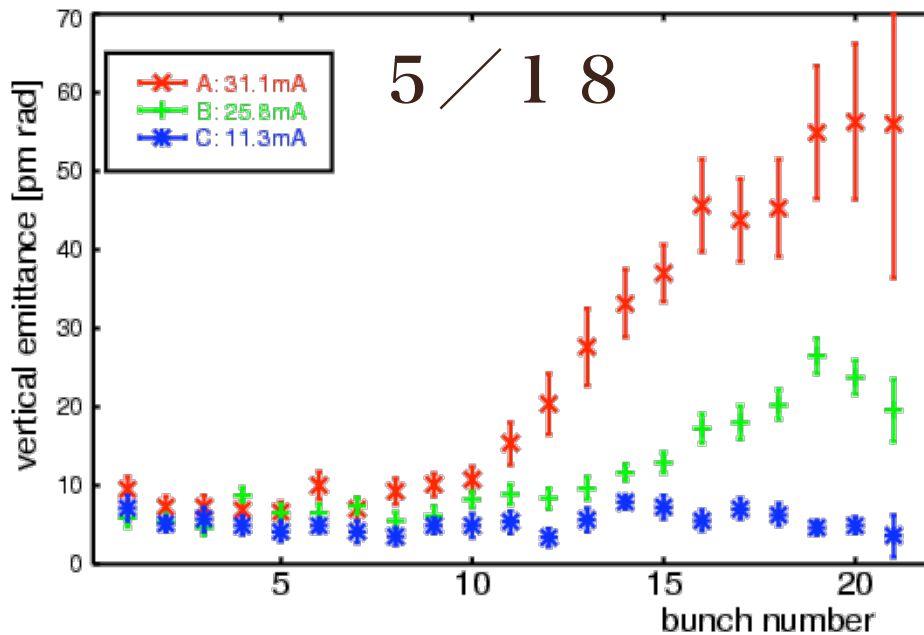


multi-bunch example

- detect timing of each event

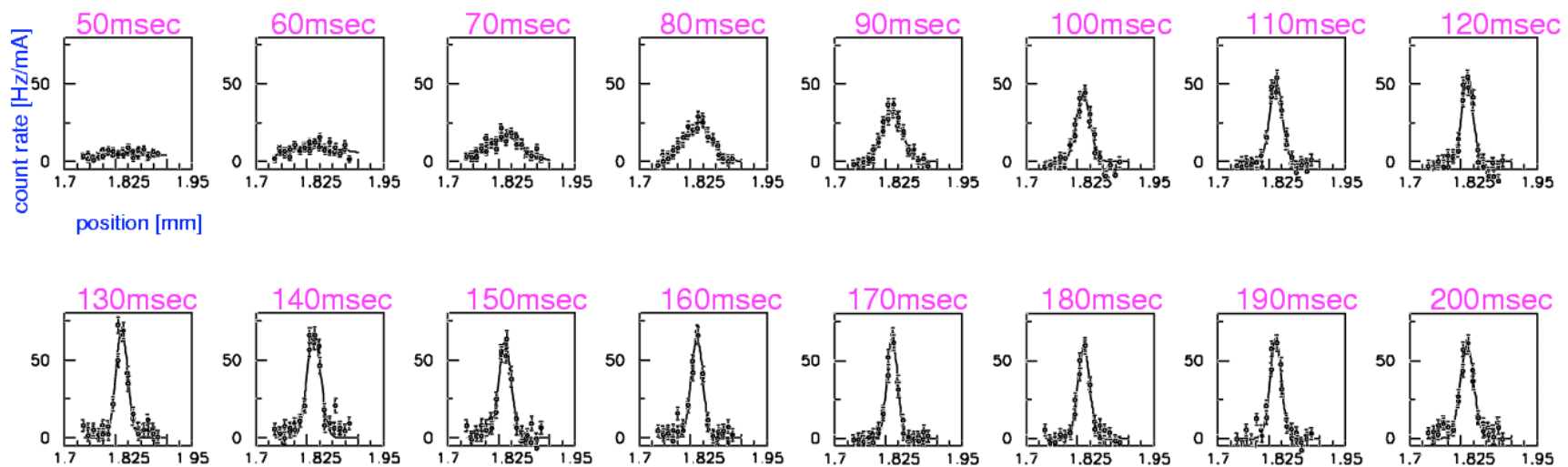
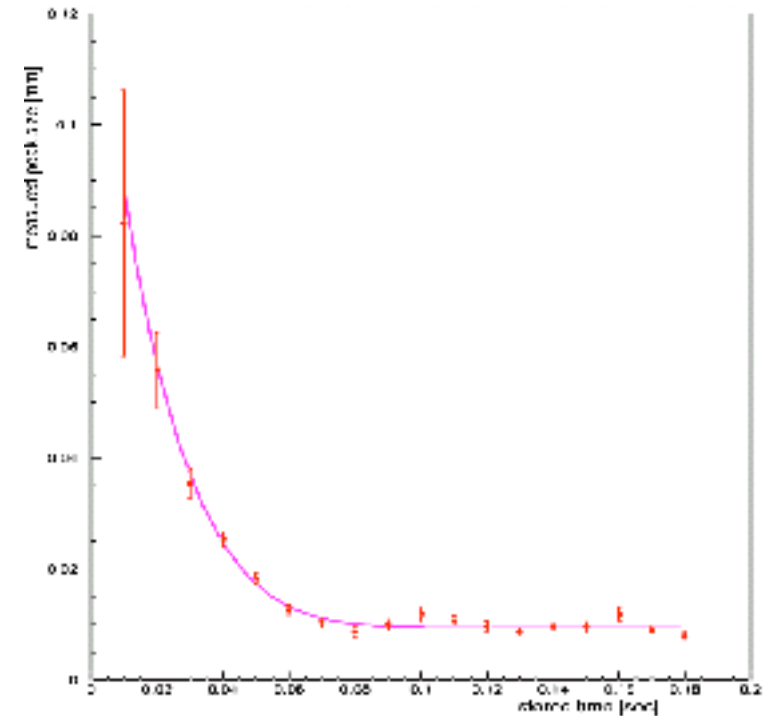

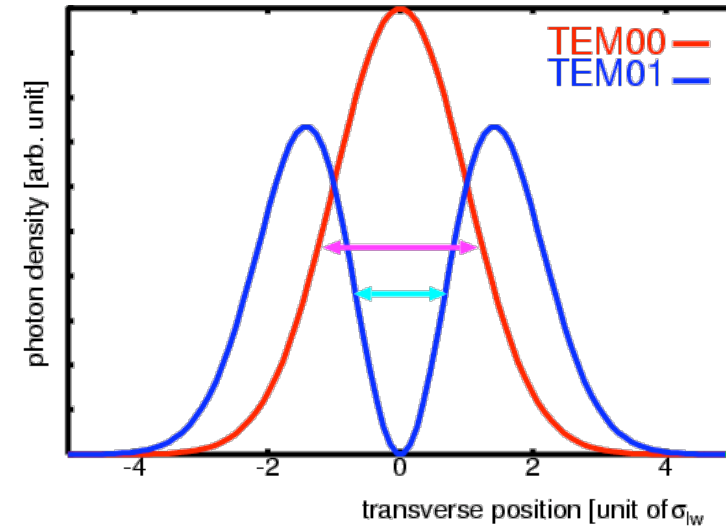
emittance damping

- measure beam size at different timing after injection



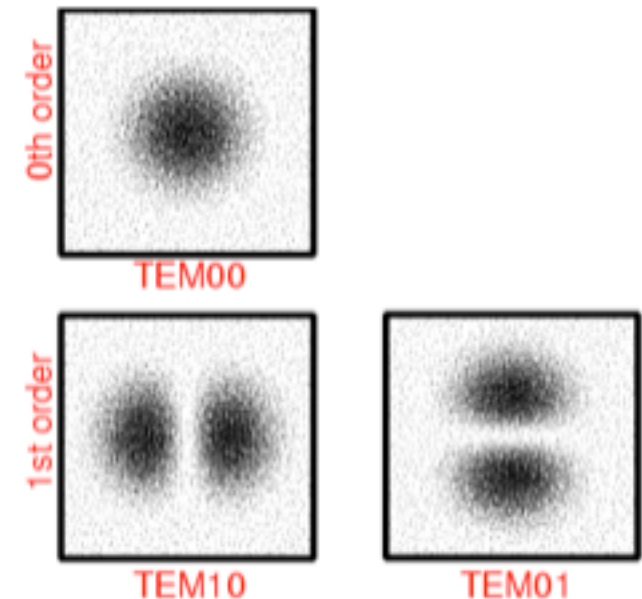
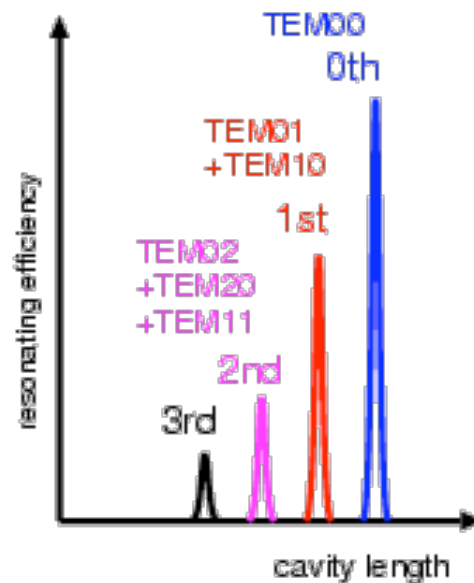
HOM

- smaller structure in higher transverse modes
- selective excitation of TEM01 mode
 - degeneration with TEM10
 - excitation efficiency



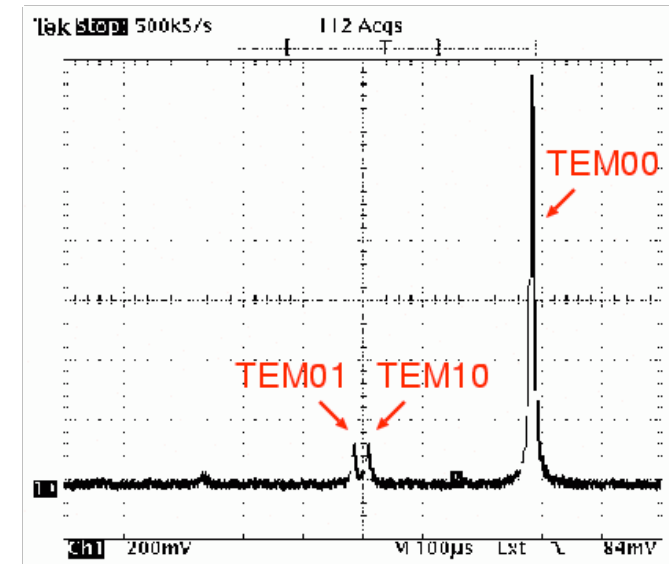
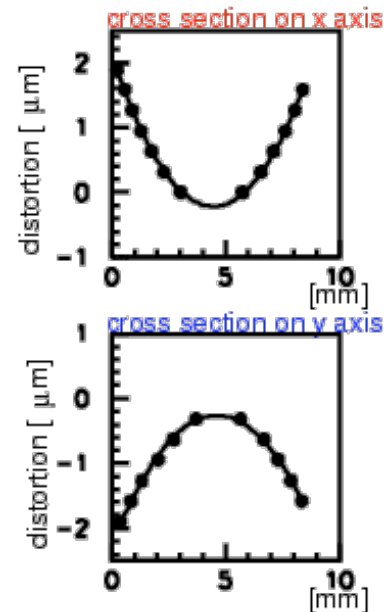
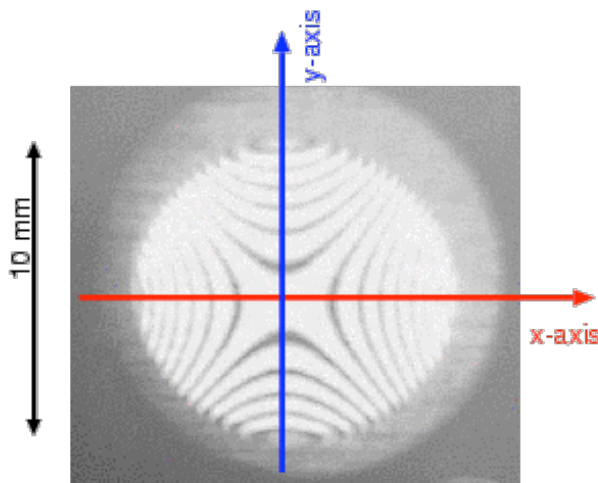
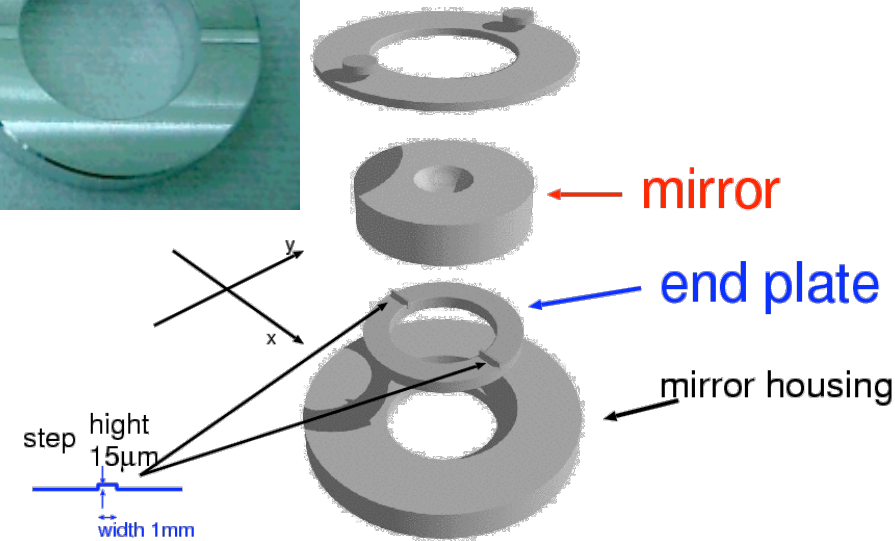
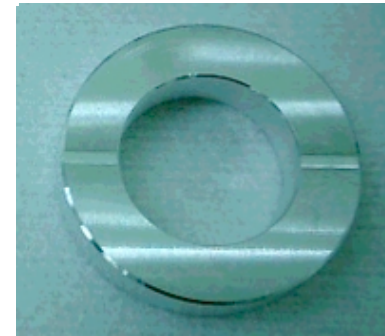

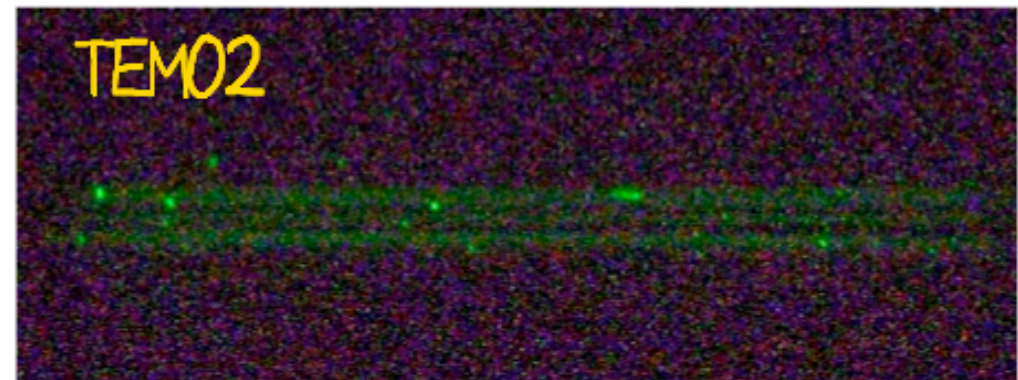
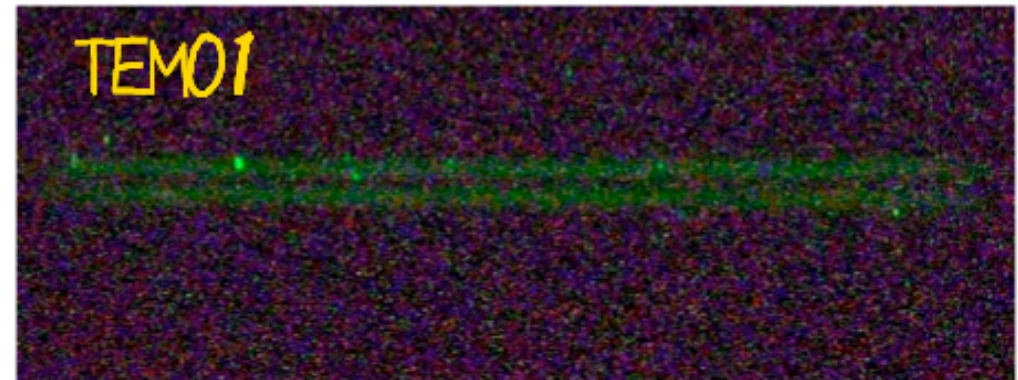
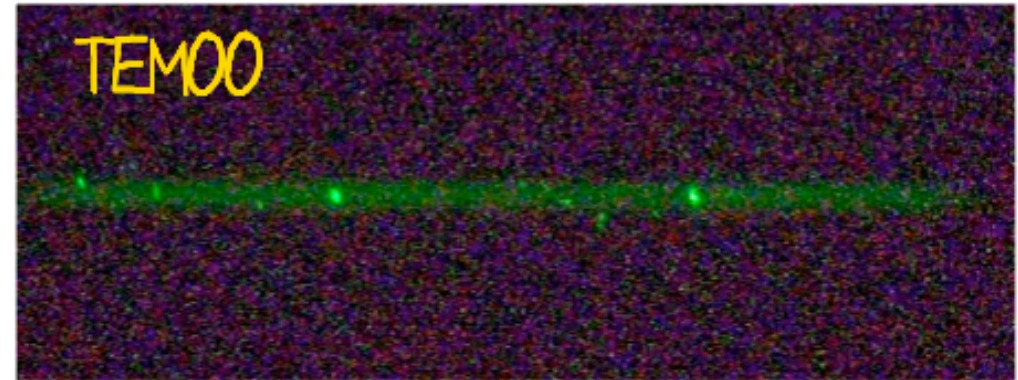
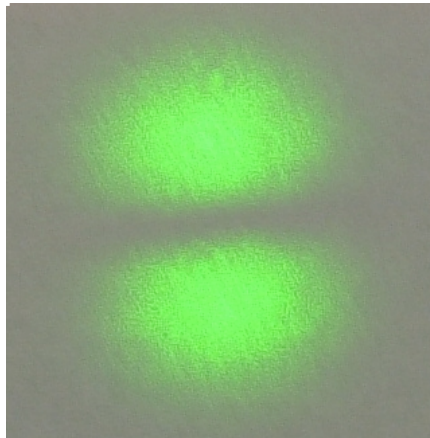


efficient excitation of TEM01

 - flip phase to increase dipole component



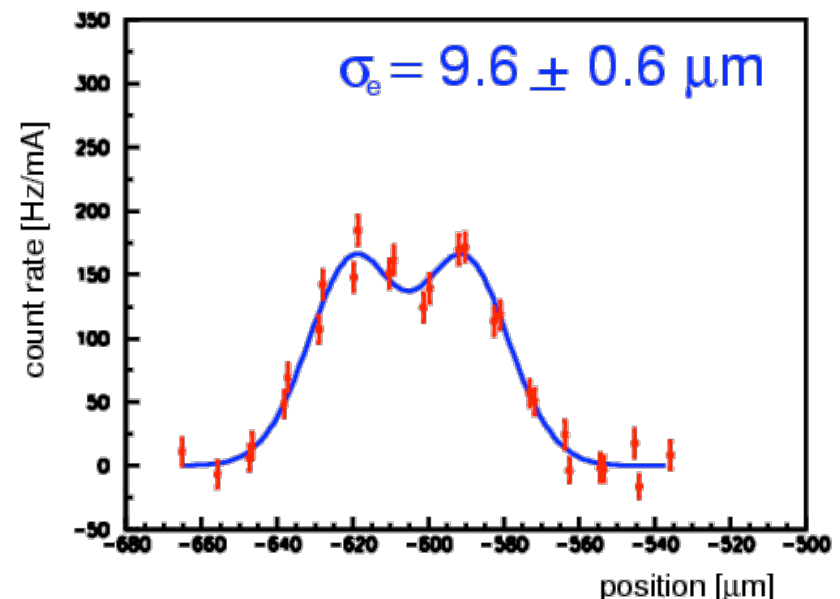
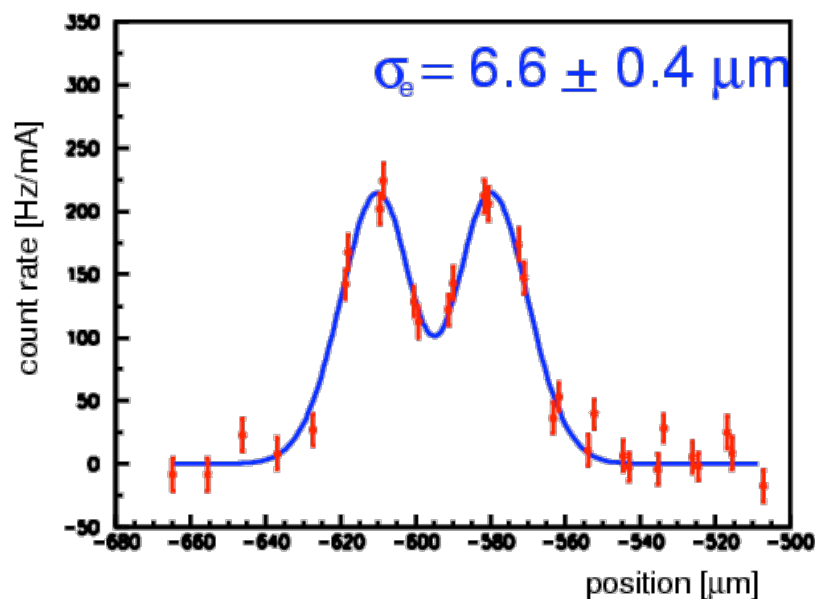
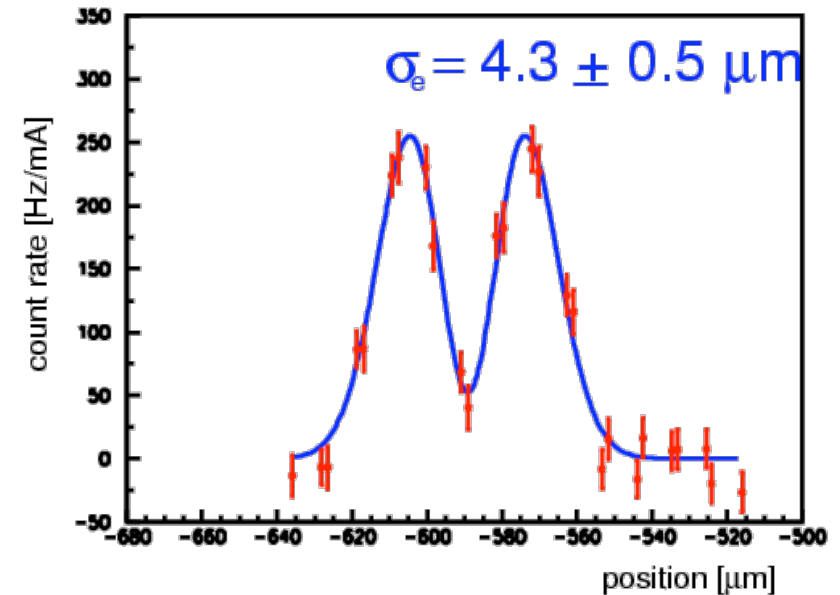

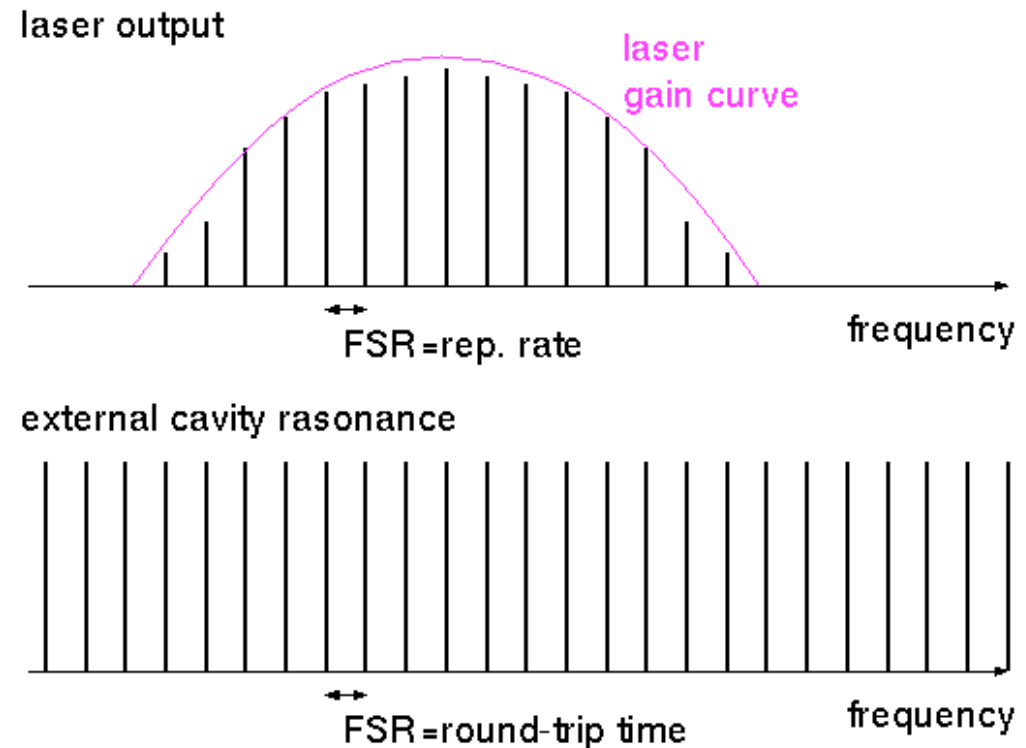
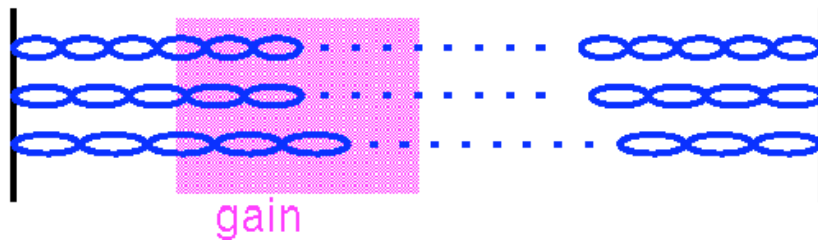
- fitting
 - both laser size, e-beam size are free parameters.

$$\left(\frac{\sigma_{lw}^2}{\sigma_e^2 + \sigma_{lw}^2} \cdot y^2 + \sigma_e^2 \right) \exp \left(-\frac{y^2}{2(\sigma_e^2 + \sigma_{lw}^2)} \right)$$

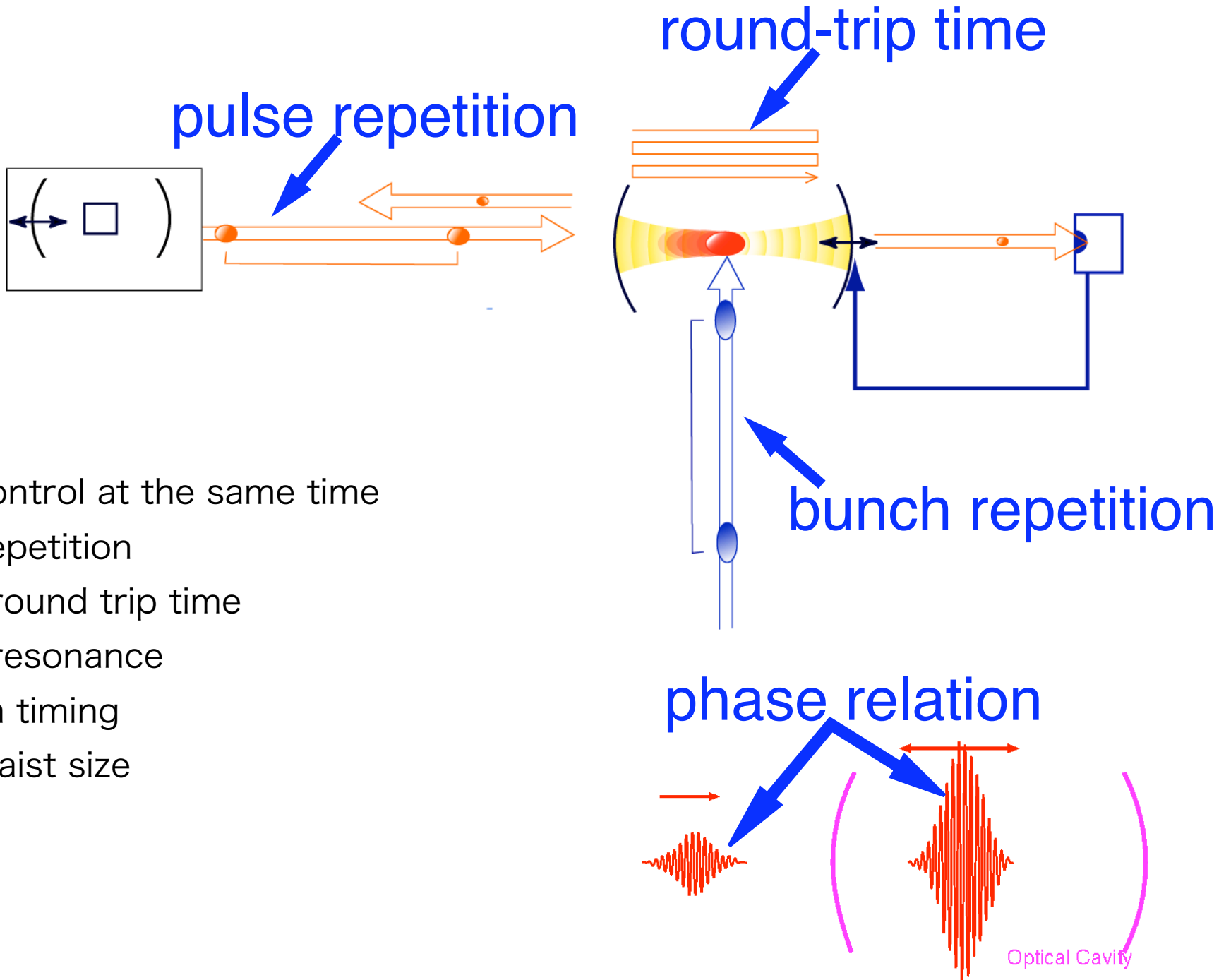


mode-lock laser case

- inside the cavity of mode lock laser
 - many longitudinal modes
 - phase relation of the modes makes a short laser pulse
- external cavity
 - also has many longitudinal modes
 - all laser modes are accepted if laser cavity length = external cavity length



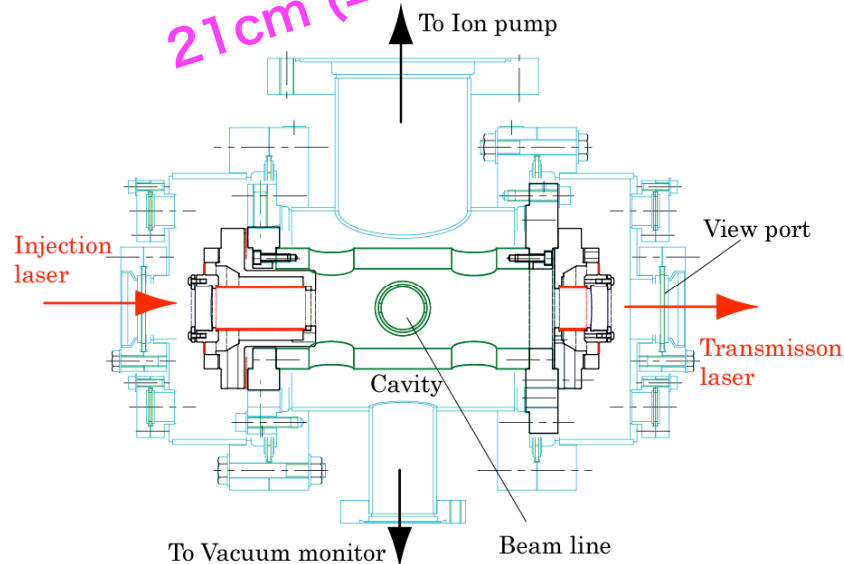
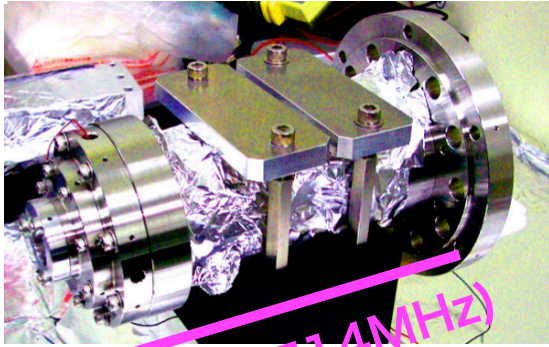
time domain



- need to control at the same time
 - laser repetition
 - cavity round trip time
 - cavity resonance
 - e-beam timing
 - laser waist size

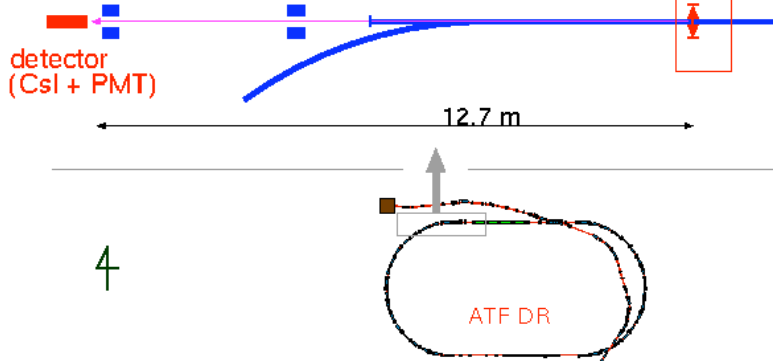
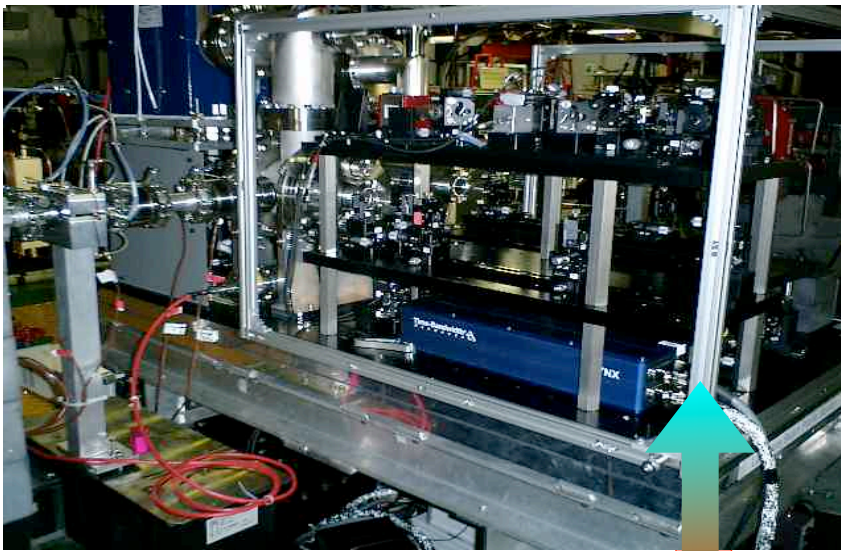
1st model for pulsed laserwire

- cavity length=21cm (714MHz), two folded 357MHz cavity
- 1064nm, passive mode-lock(SESAM)

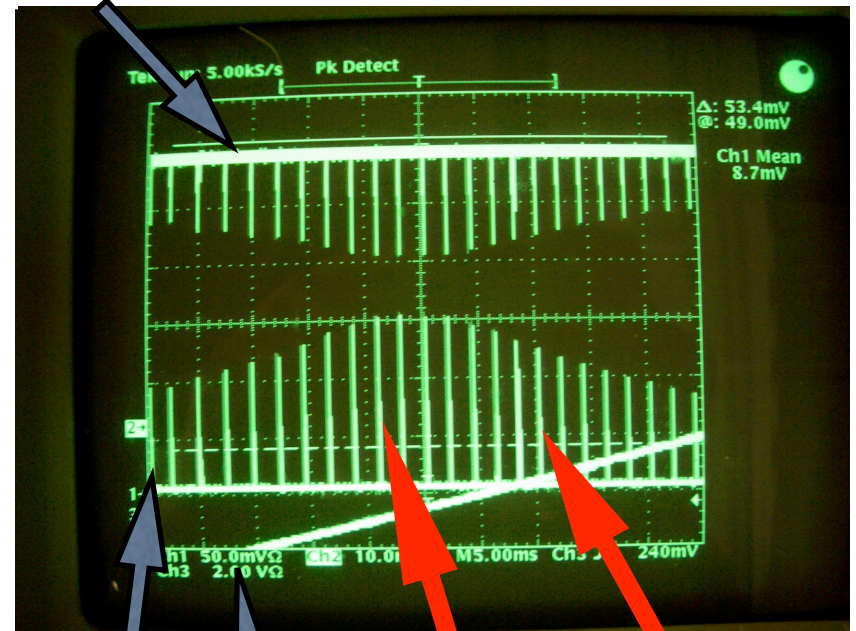

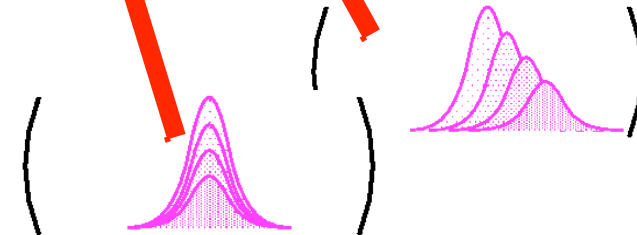


Cavity reflection

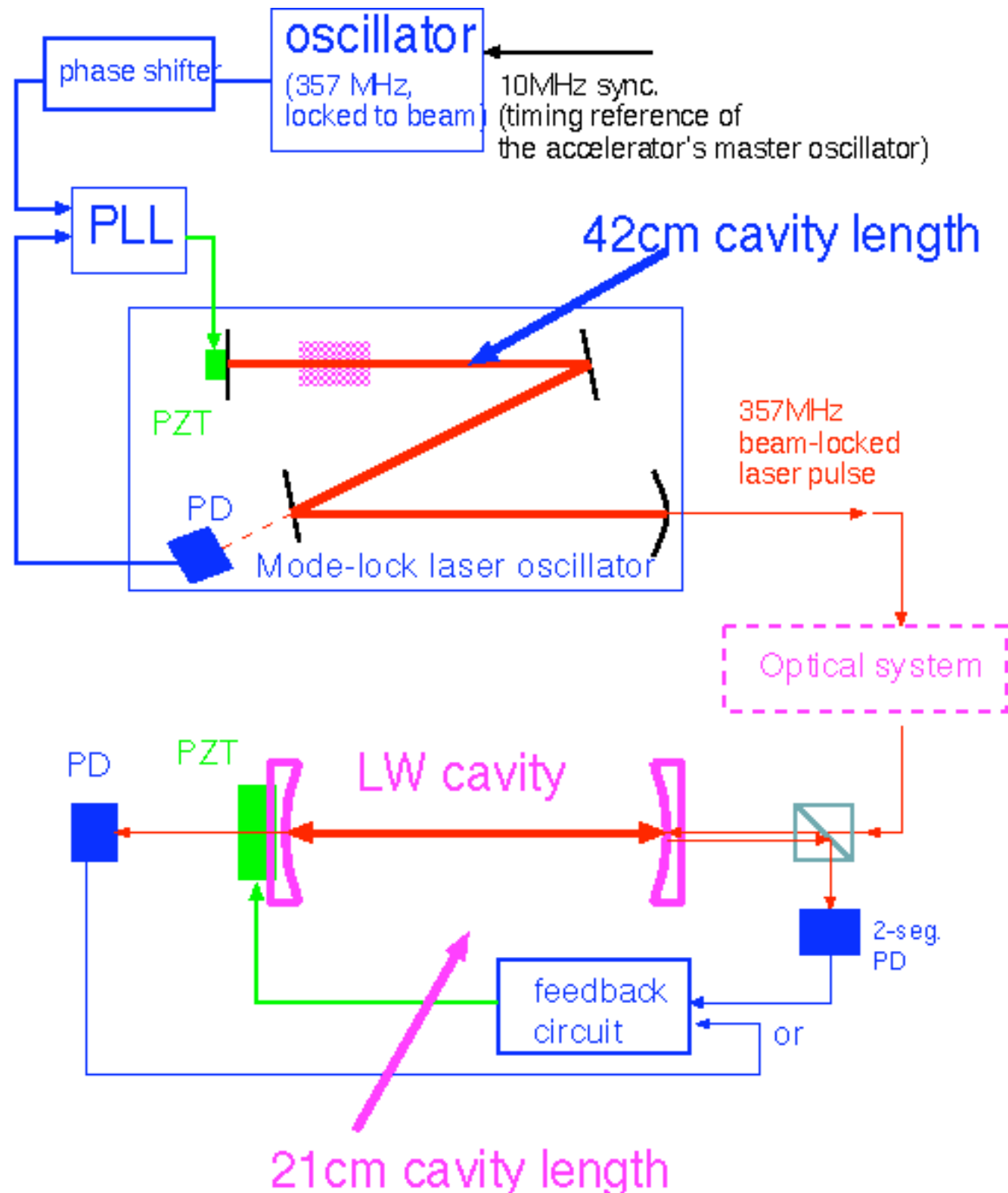
